Our friends in Birmingham have announced an Old-Time Music and Dance Institute featuring dance musician, caller and sound system workshops. The events start Friday evening and continue on Saturday. The highlight of the weekend will be a dance Saturday night featuring *Stars of the Future!* There will also be a wrap-up brunch Sunday morning.

The faculty will include caller and teacher Susan Davis, fiddler Ann Whitley and rhythm guitarist Scott Russell. Phil Foster and Reggie Bolton, the experts who run the sound for the B'ham FoOTMaD dances, will teach the sound system workshop.

The cost is \$30 per person (\$10 for the sound system workshop - includes dinner) and the venue is the YWCA, 2300 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue North in Birmingham.
