FOOTMAD AT MENTONE!

The annual Old-Time Music & Dance Weekend sponsored by the Birmingham Friends of Old-Time Music And Dance (FOOTMAD) organization will be held August 14-16 at Riverview Camp in Mentone. Riverview has a beautiful open-sided, wooden-floored dance hall and a waterfront on the Little River, whose chilly waters feel great in August.

For the past 22 years the weekend has featured great old-time bands and musicians such as James Bryan and Norman Blake, Lotus Dickey, Ralph Blizzard and the New Southern Ramblers, the Freight Hoppers, the Red Hots, Big Hoedown, Red Mountain White Trash, the Monks, and many more. The core activity of the weekend is dancing, but also on the schedule are jams (slow and regular), a concert by the featured band, a late-night swing or Cajun dance, Sunday morning gospel singing, a clogging workshop, swimming, and a wacky waterfront drama or pageant. The Kate and Gus Show*, a special program for children ages 5-12, keeps them busy and happy while their parents dance.

Campers stay in cabins or bring their own tents. Some also stay in bed-and-breakfasts and or rent chalets in the area. FOOTMAD furnishes two breakfasts and campers are asked to bring a contribution to the Saturday night potluck and any other food or beverages they need. Everyone at the camp is expected to volunteer for a congenial bit of cooking or

cleaning during the weekend, which helps FOOTMAD keep costs low.

JULY 18 ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING

On July 18 the annual meeting of the NACDS membership was held in the gymnasium of Faith Presbyterian Church.

President Carol Mevin called the meeting to order. No other fools being present, Carol nominated Kevin Riggs to record the minutes, and she announced the agenda of the meeting: to vote on proposed changes to the bylaws, to present the slate of new officers proposed by the nominating committee, to solicit other nominations for officers, and to vote for officers.

Carol read the pertinent extent section of article 6, the subject of the proposed change: "The elected officers of the NACDS are President, President-Elect, Secretary, Treasurer, Newsletter Editor, Property Custodian, Membership Chairman, and dance series Producers. All terms of office are one year, and with the exception of the Property custodian, Newsletter Editor, dance series Producers, and Treasurer, no individual may hold any given office for more than two years consecutively."

Carol then read the proposed amendment: "The elected officers of the NACDS are President, President Elect, Secretary, Treasurer, Newsletter Editor, Property Custodian, Membership Chairman, dance series Producers, and Webmaster. All terms of office are one year, but individuals may be re-elected to successive terms. The duties of the officers shall be:" add "i: the Webmaster shall 1. Maintain the NACDS webpage to provide current information to the membership and the public 2. Maintain and create content for NACDS Facebook page or other social networking site."

Carol called a vote on the proposed changes. The vote carried unanimously in favor of the changes.

Carol opened the floor for other nominations.

No other nominations being offered, Doug Roth motioned to vote by acclamation for the officers proposed by the nominating committee. Jane Ewing seconded, the vote was called, and the slate proposed by the nominating committee was elected intact by unanimous acclaim.
