### BYLAWS CHANGES

Under Article 6: Elected Officers

Change: *The elected officers of the NACDS are President, President-Elect, Secretary, Treasurer, Newsletter Editor, Property Custodian, Membership Chairman, and dance series producers. All terms of office are one year, and with the exception of the Property custodian, Newsletter Editor, dance series producers, and treasurer, no individual may hold any given office for more than two years consecutively. The duties of the officers shall be:*
